Steps we are taking to protect you, our team and ourselves from COVID-19

- 1. Screening all patients by a questionnaire for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and taking their temperature. If any symptoms, they will not be treated and sent home and advised to contact their physician for testing.
- 2. Magazines have been removed from reception room since these items are difficult to clean.
- 3. All team members and doctors have been tested for COVID-19 and tested negative.
- 4. All team members and both doctors will record their temperature and any symptoms before the start of each day and maintain social distancing when feasible.
- 5. Separating patients by six feet in reception room. We also have separated chairs in the lobby. Please wear a mask and wash hands with hand sanitizer available on front counter when you enter the office. If filling out a medical history or COVID-19 consent for treatment form, use your own pen or you will be given a disinfected pen.
- 6. Accompanying rides are asked to wait in the lobby or in their cars.
- 7. Plexiglass shields are placed at front desk to shield any transmission.
- 8. All operatories are separated by floor to ceiling walls and doors are kept closed in the main two operatories during the rare aerosol producing procedures.
- 9. Air filters placed throughout office that are proven to filter out coronavirus. Eight different air filters that would handle an office of 6000 sq.ft. are running 24/7. Our office is 1600 sq.ft.
- 10. In addition, the air, and surfaces in each operatory are sterilized by 15 minutes of UV light proven to kill coronavirus after any procedure that might produce aerosol. We also have a UV wand that will sterilize most items in five to ten seconds.
- 11. We have N95 masks (99.9% filtration) that are fit tested and level 3 masks (98% filtration), safety glasses, face shields, hair covers, foot covers, gloves, and gowns for all team members.
- 12. All instruments are heat pressure sterilized.
- 13. Aerosol producing procedures are minimized during treatment.
- 14. High volume evacuators will be used when indicated for aerosol producing procedures.
- 15. We have special over the patient suction devices that greatly minimize any aerosol escaping.
- 16. Commonly touched areas are disinfected throughout the day.
- 17. Operatory chairs and light handles etc., are covered by protective wraps and then wiped down with a high-level disinfectant.
- 18. At office and home, wash hands frequently and do not touch your mouth, nose, or eyes.

- 19. All patients pre-rinse with either 1.5% hydrogen peroxide or 1% Betadine, both of which are proven to kill coronavirus on contact.
- 20. For protection at home, we recommend irrigating with dilute bleach (one teaspoon to 8 ounces of water) once per day and rinsing with dilute bleach (one teaspoon to 4 ounces of water) once per day. If unable to irrigate, rinse twice per day. After irrigating or rinsing wet a Q-tip cotton swab with the dilute bleach and clean the inside of your nose as high as comfortable. If uncomfortable with bleach, 3% hydrogen peroxide diluted in half could also be used.
- 21. When grocery shopping etc., wear your mask and disposable gloves.
